

Digital Inclusion Factoids

Chautauqua County, New York

Positives

- 95.1% of households (51,424) have access to some sort of internet-enabled device.
 - Desktops or laptops reach is 72.9% of households (39,420).
 - Smartphones reach is 89.1% of households (48,180).
 - Tablets reach is 61.0% of households (32,985).
- 92.7% of households (50,127) have some form of broadband internet subscription.
 - High-speed wired Broadband (cable/fiber/DSL) reach is 75.9% of households (41,042).
 - Cellular data plans reach is 86.9% of households (46,990).

Negatives

- Just over 7% of households (3,885) lack internet coverage of any type.
- About 14.1% of households (7,624) rely only on cellular internet — often expensive and unreliable, which limits speed and functionality.
- About 12.0% of households (6,489) rely on smartphone-only households, which limits speed and functionality.
