Announcements

- Pete also shared that Native American Community Services received renewed grant funding through 2024. He thanked everyone for their support.

State Digital Equity Plan - Draft for Public Comment

- The group discussed the state's draft digital equity plan ([website](#) | [PDF](#)), which is open for public comment until 5:00PM on December 6th, 2023.
- Comments must be submitted using a [web form](#) on the ConnectALL website. The ConnectALL Office has enlisted regional digital equity coalitions to hold public comment sessions to gather feedback.
- Don encouraged everyone to review the draft, focusing particularly on the Implementation Section, which contains tables outlining goals, strategies, and outcome measures identified by the state.
- Heidi expresses appreciation for highlighting both positives and negatives in comments.

Public Comment Sessions for State Digital Equity Plan

- With the public comment period closing in early December, we need to move quickly if we are going to organize public comment sessions.
- Our target dates will be the last week of November. We will aim to have one online session with two in-person sessions. Ideally, one in-person session will be in the Northtowns and the other in Allegany County.
- Don asked for volunteers to help with these public comment sessions.

 - Elizabeth Freas and Christine Carr-Barmasse also volunteered to help.

Coalition Convening

- Following a Policy, Advocacy, & Funding Committee meeting, there was a strong desire to hold a coalition convening in January 2024 to align with stated goals and build relationships among members.
- The target date for this is in the last week of January 2024, in part to help us identify and initiate projects before the state releases its notice of funding opportunity (expected around June 2024).
- Don again asked for volunteers to help coordinate the convening.
 - Sherry Sherrill, Pete Hill, and Katie Pieri volunteered to help out.

Governance Revisions

- Based on high levels of burnout and overwhelm amongst Coalition members, along with a desire to incorporate new voices into the Coalition's work, Don intends to transition from a standing committee model to project-based workgroups.
- This creates the need for a Steering Committee, with at least half of its members coming from the community.

- With the ideal size for the Steering Committee being between six and eight members, it will be essential to recruit additional coalition community members. Don reminded the Coalition members that there is a stipend associated with the position, with the expectation of committing up to 10 hours per month.
