Announcements

- Hannah Brecher announced the annual Center for Self advocacy Healthcare Summit planned for October. The event will tentatively be held at the Jacobs Center, with Dr. Michael Lamb's continued support. The summit will focus on healthcare navigation, including electronic health records and digital inclusion connections. Committee work is beginning for event planning, with opportunities for community members to participate.
- CJ Banks announced the launch of Villa Maria's Creative Arts Entrepreneurship Center. First
 event scheduled for October 4th at Villa Maria College in partnership with SCORE and the SBA. It
 will be an all-day event covering business startup and management, including digital creation,
 intellectual property, and funding information. Contact information available for interested

- CJ Banks announced the next Al Equity Task Force meeting scheduled for October. The task force is focusing on core goals and actionable initiatives.
- Jeremy Besch announced two upcoming Per Scholas cohorts starting in October. The in-person
 IT support cohort currently enrolling with available seats, and there will be a new remote class
 option starting October 14th for students unable to make daily on-campus commitments.

- Liz Warkentin announced plans for two cohorts of Mission: Ignite's Tech 360 Basic Chrome courses next month. Classes will be held at Mission: Ignite's community learning lab. Maximum capacity of 10 people (typically 5 per cohort).
- Christine Carr-Barmasse announced a new pathway partnership with Per Scholas for hardware training. The program is designed for Per Scholas graduates seeking additional hands-on experience. Participants can join Mission: Ignite's tech team for continued training and support.
- Megan Farry promoted NYATEP's annual conference in October (2025 Fall Conference).
- Megan Farry also noted that applications are open for the Workforce Policy and Advocacy Academy (<u>Workforce Academy</u>).
- Susan Kirkpatrick from Mission: Ignite reported successful outreach to Representative Tim
 Kennedy's office. Inspired by South Carolina Representative Jim Clyburn's video supporting
 Digital Inclusion Week, Representative Kennedy has agreed to film a 30-60 second video
 supporting the Coalition's work. The video will focus on the digital divide, coalition activities,
 and pledging support. The final video will be shared with all members for use on social media
 and newsletters.

Technical Assistance Grant Updates

Regional Digital Literacy Survey

- Don Matteson provided updates on the New York State Digital Equity Technical Assistance Grant's primary deliverable.
- Initial survey draft from consultants was off-target, focusing on general digital inclusion rather than digital literacy.
- Extensive feedback and alternative draft provided to consultants.
- Project running approximately 4-5 weeks behind schedule.
- December 31st deadline remains in place, though ConnectALL contact Nazeer Jeffries indicated willingness to extend into early 2026 if needed.
- Survey aims to capture community-wide digital literacy skills beyond just program participants.

Training and Development

Results-Based Accountability (RBA) Training

- Four coalition members are currently undergoing RBA certification training.
- Two RBA 101 training sessions scheduled:
 - October 3rd, 9:00 AM 12:00 PM (virtual)
 - October 10th, 9:00 AM 12:00 PM (virtual)
- Sessions will be recorded for reference.
- October 3rd session covers RBA overview, including turn-the-curve thinking, population accountability, performance accountability, and result statements.
- October 10th session builds on the first; attendance at both sessions recommended for full comprehension.

- Research focuses on ZIP code-based datasets from FCC, census, and other resources.
- Aims to measure broadband adoption versus access, addressing the gap between availability and utilization.
- Potential collaboration with local mapping and data analysis initiatives.

Infrastructure Updates

ErieNet

- Discussion of Erie County's fiber network infrastructure project.
- County received \$5 million grant from ConnectALL's Municipal Infrastructure Program.
- Project currently under construction with expected completion mid to late 2026.
- Early network segments anticipated to be operational by early 2026.
- Coalition members expressed interest in obtaining detailed project updates.
- Action item to reach out to Mike Breeden (County CIO) for comprehensive briefing.
